WHY PROSTATE CANCER?

- Prostate cancer is the most diagnosed cancer in Australian men.
- Approximately 25,500 new cases are diagnosed with prostate cancer each year.
- 1 in 12 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer
- 95% of Australian men diagnosed with prostate cancer survive for at least 5 years.
- Almost 3,700 Australian men die of prostate cancer each year.

Why are we asking you to be involved?

- Every day 55 Australian men will be told they have prostate cancer.
- 1 in 5 men have a risk of developing prostate cancer in their life time.
- Prostate cancer is the most diagnosed cancer in Australia.
- 9 families lose a loved one to prostate cancer every day.
- 70% of research applications are unfunded.

WHAT THIS FUNDRAISING EVENT CAN ACHIEVE

- \$12,500 could provide funding for a researcher working for one month on a project to reduce side effects post treatment.
- \$30,000 could provide funding for a senior scientist for three months working on a project to improve treatments for prostate cancer that has spread to the bones.
- \$50,000 could fund a project to improve early–diagnosis for men with a family history of prostate cancer.

Proceeds from this event will be donated to the Prostate Cancer Research Group at the Biomedicine Discovery Institute, Monash University, to fund world leading, innovative research and to support men and their families affected by prostate cancer.

Their innovative research program has a strong translational approach, involving lab-based studies with tissues donated by patients with prostate cancer. Their collaborative studies with clinicians and patient advocates address questions that are relevant to patient care. The findings have the potential to improve the management and outcomes of men with different stages of prostate cancer. Recent studies have informed international guidelines for diagnosis of prostate cancer and led to new clinical trials.
